

Special Work Session Meeting

On Monday, May 21, 2007, at 6:00 pm the Special Planning Commission Work Session Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Eric Minks. Other members present were Carl Sanford, Greg McBroom, and Eugene Stoeckel. Planning Commission members Tom Braun, Larry Ziebarth and John Moosbrugger were absent.

The purpose of the meeting was to review and discuss Princeton Townships Comprehensive Plan.


The main topics of discussion were river conservation and zoning issues.

After much discussion, a motion was made by Greg McBroom to change the zoning map to expand the width of the 169 commercial corridor to 2,000 feet from the road right of way, and to also add to the commercial zone, 2,000 from the road right of way on Highway 95, West of Princeton, on both sides of the road, and to eliminate the River Conservation on the west branch, and revert it back to Agricultural. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Eugene Stoeckel moved that the Planning Commission amend the motion for the 2,000 feet, and instead to follow property lines as close as possible. Greg McBroom accepted that. Carl Sanford recommended that they amend the motion on the River Conservation for West Branch and instead create a second River Conservation zone for the West Branch. Chairperson Minks asked for those in favor of the new motion with the amendments, no one responded. Motion Died.

A motion was made by Greg McBroom to change the zoning to expand the 169 commercial zone to 2,000 feet from the road right of way in width or to follow adjacent property lines as close as possible and to expand the commercial district to intake Highway 95 west from Princeton and to change River Conservation along the west branch to River Conservation second district. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

A Motion was made by Greg McBroom and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to adjourn the meeting at 7:43 p.m. Motion Carried.
